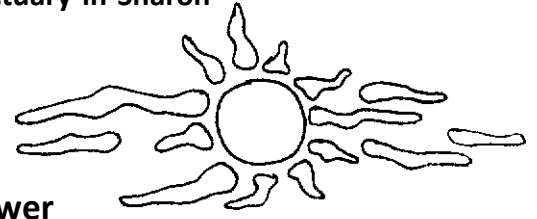


March Vacation Weeks for Private Schools

Earth Power

Session 2: Monday – Friday, March 22 – 26

Ages 5 – 12*

9 a.m. – 3 p.m. (Late option until 5 p.m. – see below)

Fee per Session: \$230 members; \$275 non-members

Late Option fee: \$10 per day

Each day we will focus on a different type of power—sun, fossil, wind, water and people. A listing of some activities can be found below.

Sun Power – Trace shadows, make sun prints, and play hide-and-seek in the shadows while learning the importance of the sun to both plants and animals.

Wind Power – Fly a homemade kite while learning how feathers and wings work. Older kids will learn how to estimate the speed and direction of the wind.

Fossil Power – Compare fires built with wood and coal while making a tasty treat! Make a “fossil” while learning how we get energy sources from the past.

People Power – Help our team to tug, dig and pull out plants that should not be here and use them to create crafts and games!

Water Power – Build a dam with the group and try to harness the power of water. Race a boat made from natural materials down a seasonal stream.

To the Ends of the Earth

Session 1: Monday – Friday, March 15 – 19

Ages 5 – 12*

Discover the differences between the North and South Poles and learn about the animals who have adapted to the polar biome. A listing of some activities can be found below.

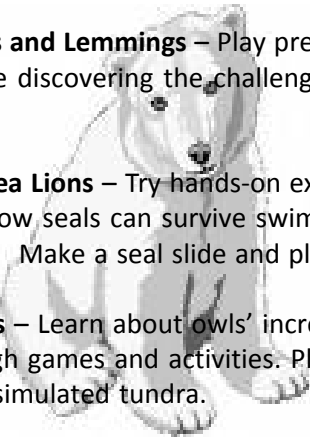
Penguins – Decorate life-size images of penguins and figure out how to tell the difference between species of these black & white birds.

Arctic Foxes and Lemmings – Play predator and prey games while discovering the challenges of hunting on the tundra.

Seals and Sea Lions – Try hands-on experiments that show you how seals can survive swimming through cold waters. Make a seal slide and play games.

Snowy Owls – Learn about owls' incredible adaptations through games and activities. Play a snowy owl game on a simulated tundra.

Polar Bears – Compare the size, diet, and habitat of black, grizzly, and polar bears with games and explorations.



About Full Day Programs: Daily themes keep the children engaged. Learning is facilitated through a combination of indoor activities, outdoor explorations, crafts, and games. A health form and information packet will be sent upon registration for those who did not attend the summer '09 Moose Hill Camp. Dress or pack for the weather since we go out every day! Bring a snack, water, and lunch.

Ages and Groups: Children are divided into groups of similar ages depending upon enrollment. * Older children may attend but must act appropriately with younger children.

About Late Option: Please specify which day(s) are needed when you register. This program includes a kosher snack and supervised free-play time. There is no fee reduction for early pick up. Program ends promptly at 5 p.m.

Refund Policy: If Moose Hill is notified one week prior to the program session, you will receive a refund minus the non-refundable deposit, which is \$50 per week and \$2 per day for the late pick-up option. No refunds will be granted after this deadline has passed.
